FOREIGN ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR EQUATORIAL GUINEA

A. - AMERICAN CITIZENS:

American citizens do not require a Visa to enter Equatorial Guinea, however if they are planning on staying for more than ninety (90) straight days they are required to apply for and acquire either a Residence or a Work Permit once they are in the country.

As American citizens arrive in Equatorial Guinea, they will be expected to present a valid passport and immunization record booklet to the border control officers.

Taking Malaria pills before travels is recommended but not required.

B.- ALL OTHERS:

To obtain an entry visa to Equatorial Guinea, all other citizens must submit to the closest Embassy or Consulate that covers the jurisdiction where the applicant currently lives.

- An original passport valid at least for the next 6 months.
- Travel documents are not accepted
- Two application forms duly filled out and signed. A passport photo is to accompany each form.
- An entry Authorization letter into Equatorial Guinea issued by the E.G. Ministry of National Security
- An invitation letter into Equatorial Guinea issued either by the Government, a private entity, or a private individual
- If traveling on tourism, a bank statement or equivalent confirming the amount of at least \$2,000.00 to cover expenses for each month he/she will spend in Equatorial Guinea.
- If traveling on business, a letter issued by the applicant's employer explaining purpose of the trip and undertaking the applicant's expenses.
- A police clearance not older than 3 months issued by a police department in the city where the applicant currently resides stating that he/she has not been convicted of any major crimes.
- Immunization record booklet

- Flight itinerary and proof of accommodation arrangements
- Payments can be in form of cash(U.S.D.), money order or company checks issued only in the United States, and should be made payable to the Embassy of Equatorial Guinea
- A postage paid return envelope should be included with the application (FedEx, DHL, UPS...)
